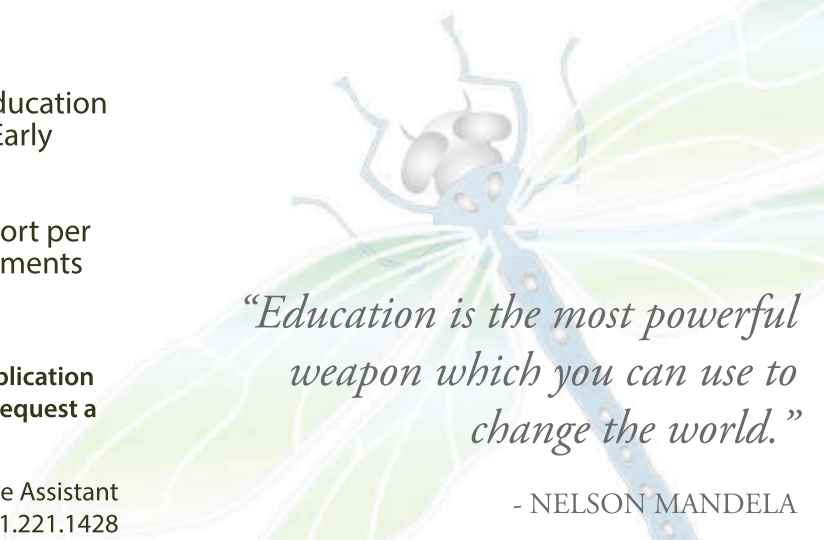

- (3) Completed Recommendation Forms
- Notarized and signed Criminal History Consent Form
- Degree of Indian Blood Certification (*or proof of descendency*)
- Application for Admission to UTTC (if not already a current student)
- Unofficial Transcript Copies (*official copy required after acceptance*)
