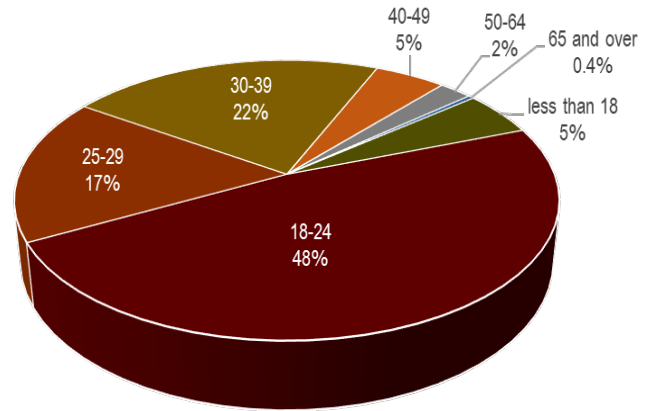

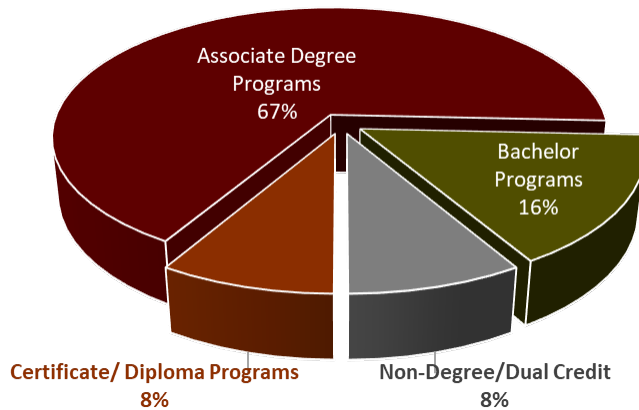

Enrollment by Program Level

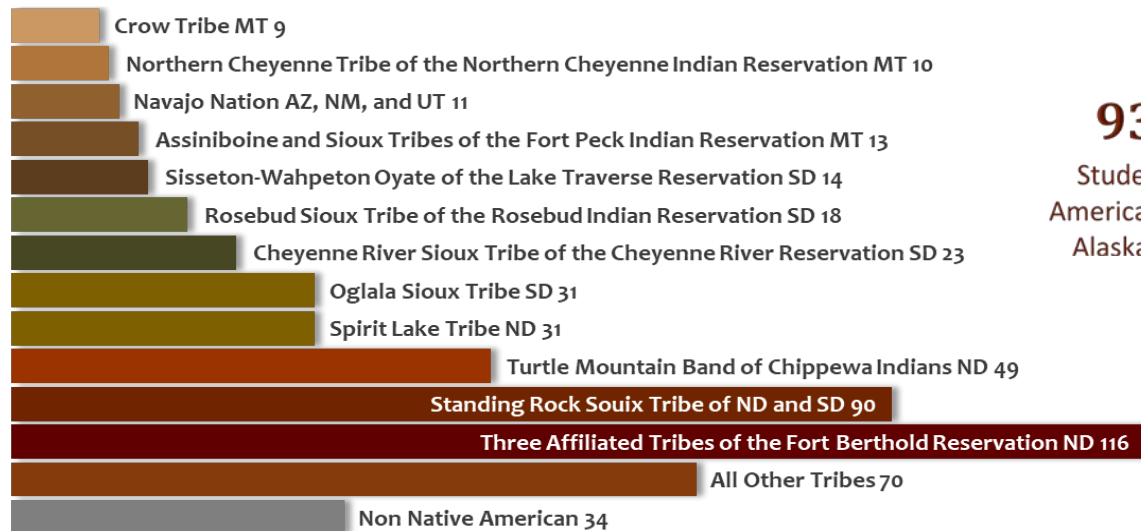

## Tribal Representation in Student Body is Diverse

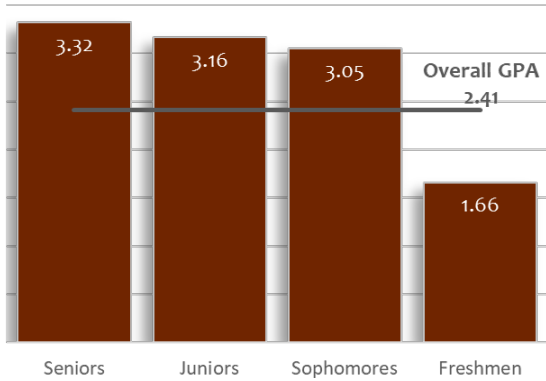

**Cumulative GPAs are stronger** for students who progress past the first year of studies.

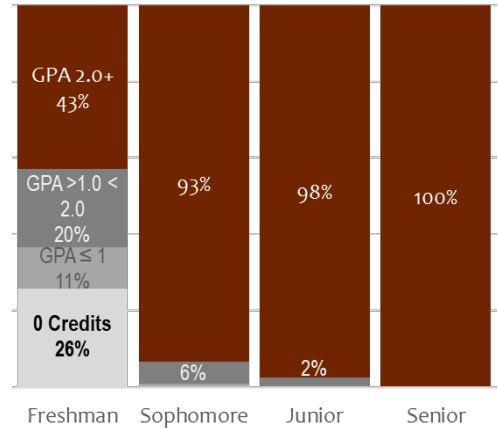

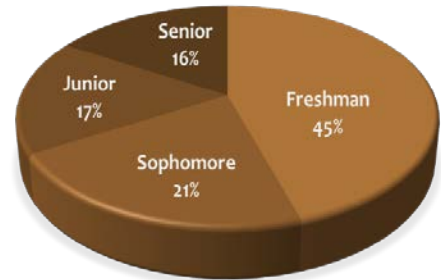

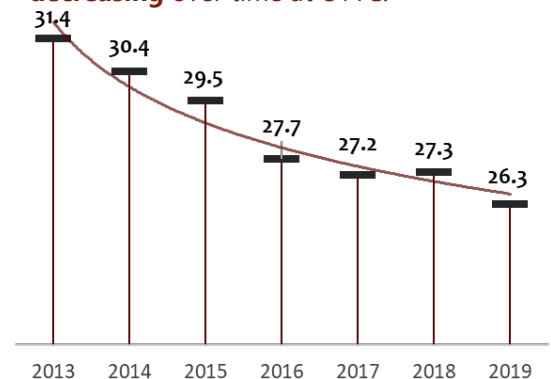
