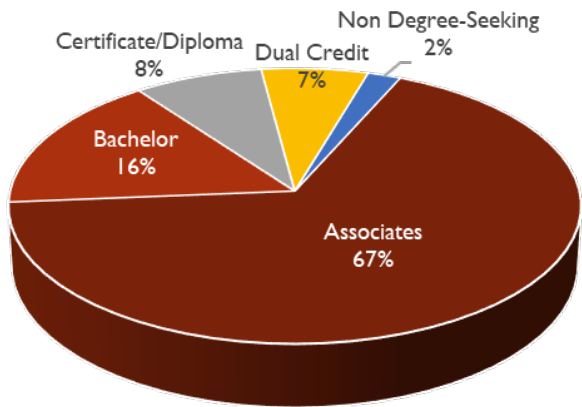

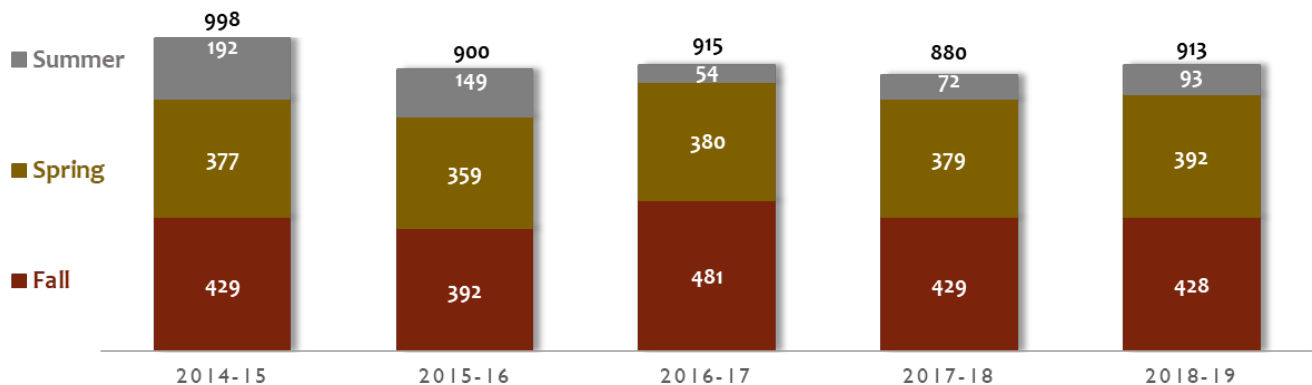

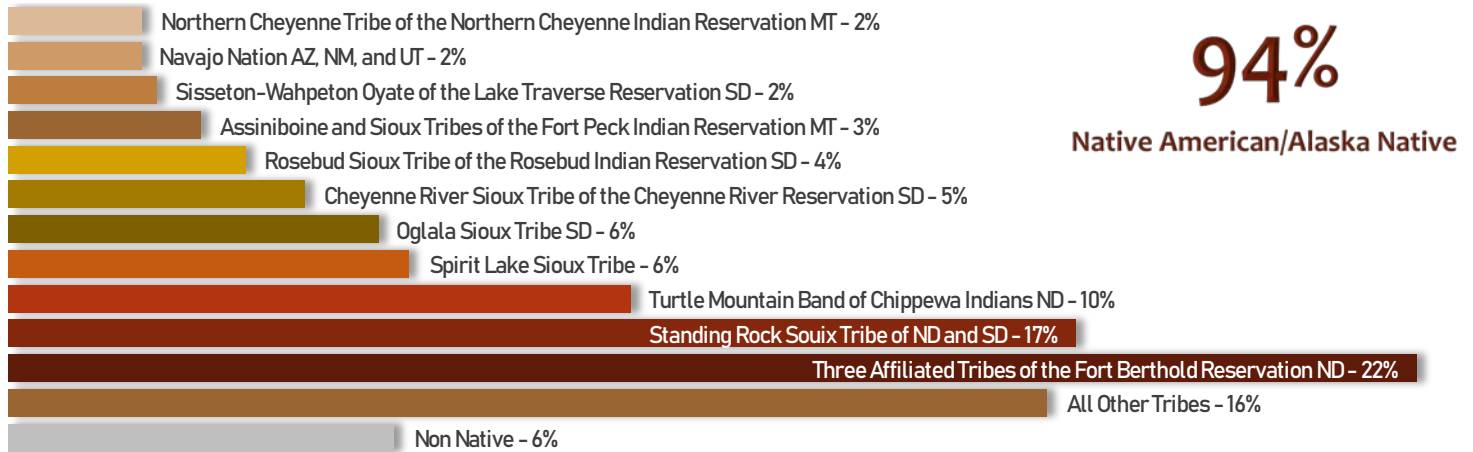

Enrollment by Tribal Affiliation

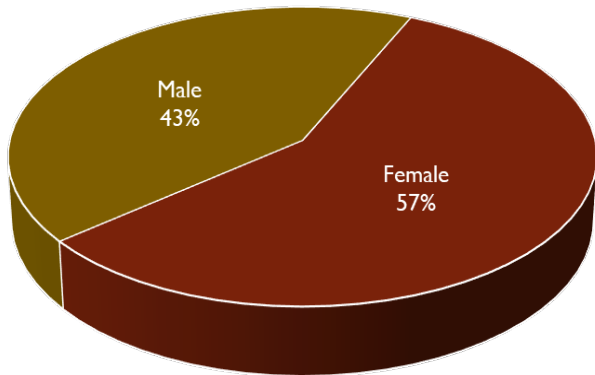


Enrollment by State Residence

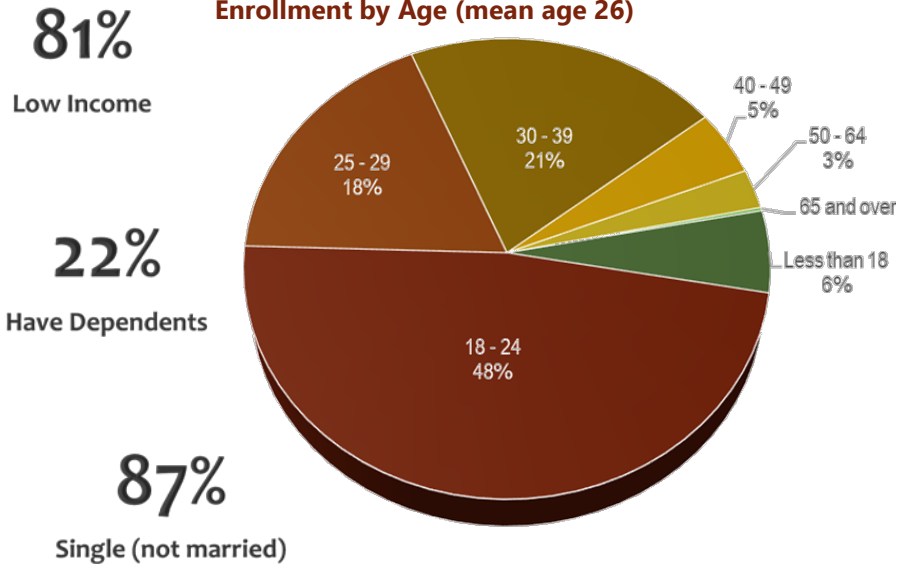

Enrollment by Gender

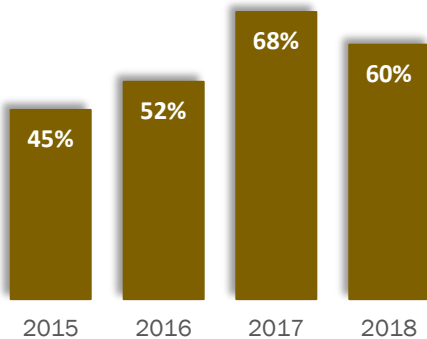


Enrollment by Age (mean age 26)



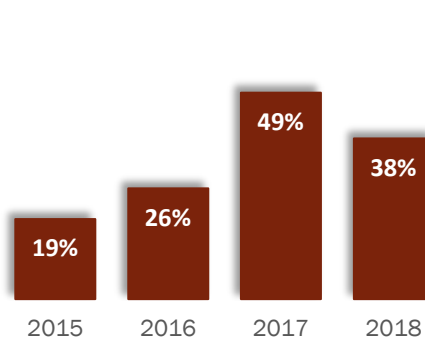

Fall to Spring Persistence



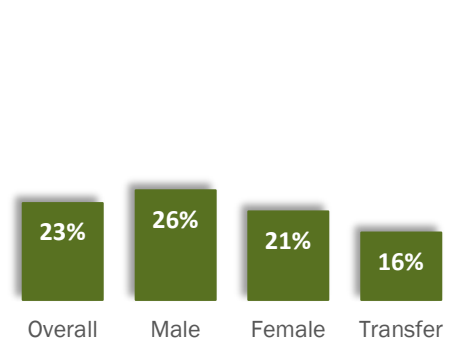
