A. Summary of Program Strengths

- Advisory council is strong

- Very strong placement rate
- Advising process for students is a team approach.
- Strong communication in the department.

- The hands-on classroom (mat room) provides learning of modern tactics and modern expectations

B. Summary of Program Challenges

- Advisory council lacks diversity and can benefit from Tribal representation.
- No articulation agreements with other TCUs or other institutions.
- Program enrollment growth has been static.
- No plan for program recruitment at the program level

C. Actionable Insights

- The Advisory board would benefit from including a former student and from a Tribal program

D. Program Action

- Retain program of study as is
- Expand program of study to another level, specialty, or delivery option
- Revise program of study to better meet the needs of students, current labor market or industry
- Consolidate program of study with another program
- Terminate program of study

E. Institutional Support Needed and/or Committed to Carry Out Action

- Ask the Director of Career Services and College Relations to track placement and alumni.
- The Enrollment Services department will work with the programs to develop a recruitment plan/process.
