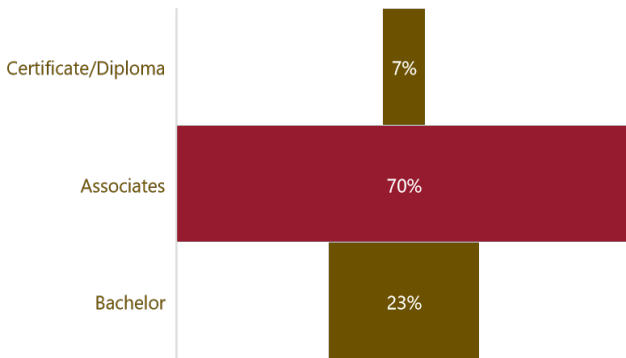

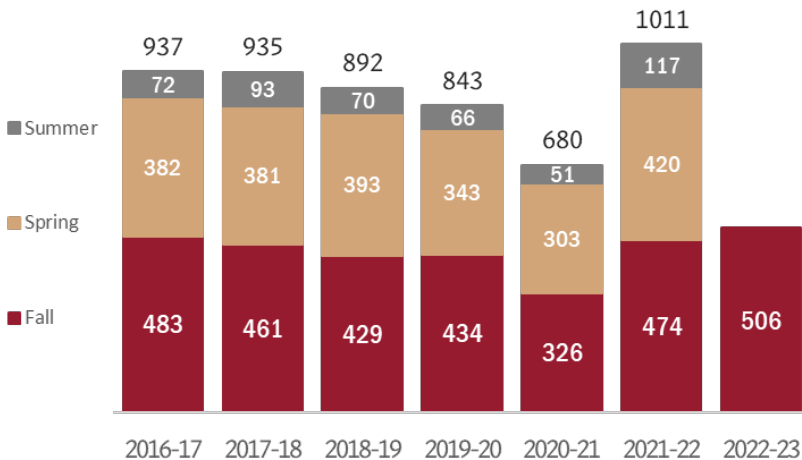

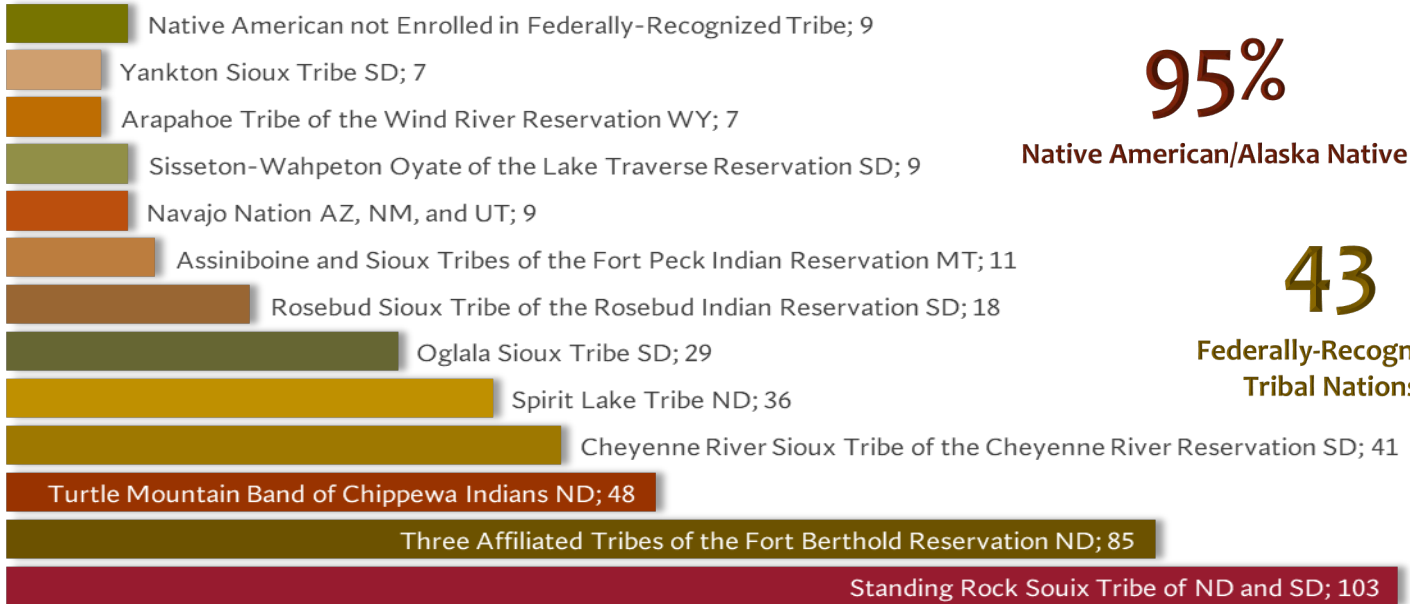

Enrollment by Tribal Affiliation



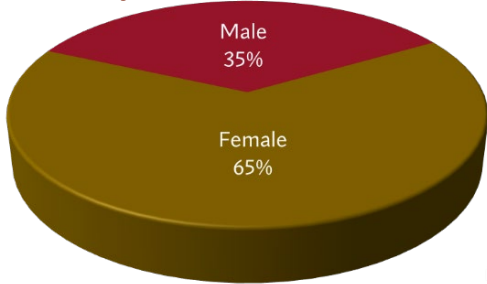

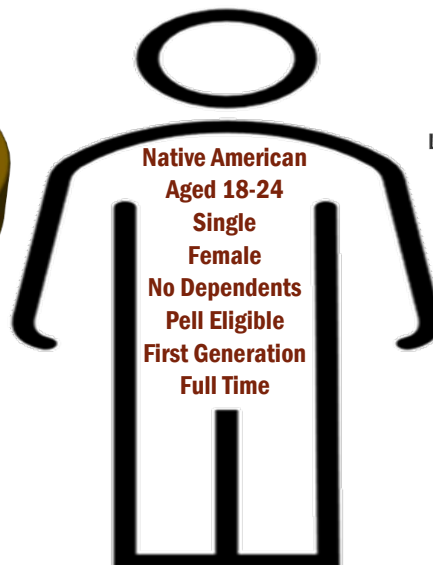
Enrollment by Gender

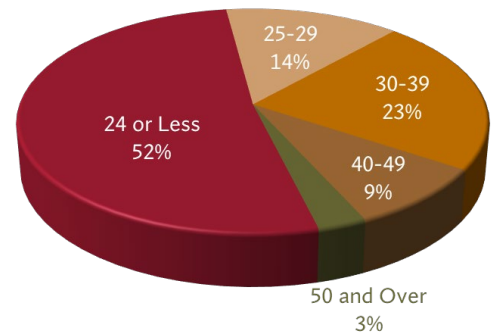

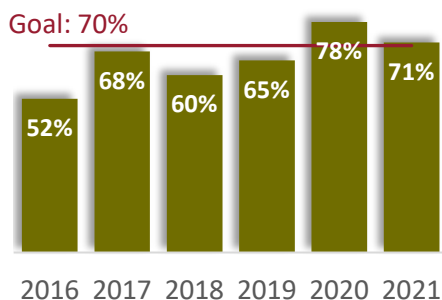
Degree-Seeking Students are Single with Dependents

Enrollment by Age (average age 27.5)



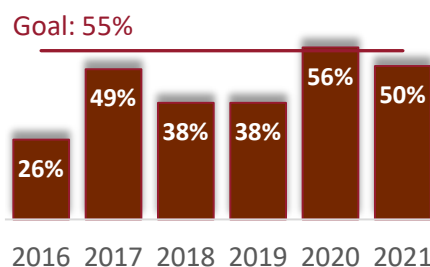

FTEIC Fall to Spring Persistence



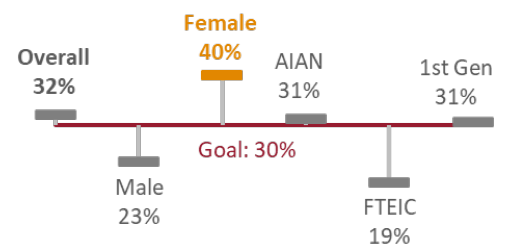
