2024 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Fargo-Moorhead Builders Exchange (FMBX) is pleased to announce that we are now accepting applications for our annual FMBX Scholarship Program. Eligible students must be enrolled in or be entering a two-year technical program or four-year college program and be in a construction-related field of study. Full-time students with a 3.0 GPA (minimum) are eligible to apply. High School students are encouraged to apply for a FMBX Scholarship if they have been accepted into a two- or four-year program for the Fall of 2024. Postsecond ary students graduating in May of 2024 are in eligible to apply.

All applications for scholarships are reviewed by the FMBX Scholarship Committee and recipients are voted on at the April 2024 Board of Directors meeting. After confirmation of the student's enrollment at a two- or four-year school, the scholarship recipients will receive a congratulatory letter and the scholarship funds will be forwarded to the college or technical school of the recipient.

Applicants are evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Community and school involvement
- Relationship of the student's field of study to the construction industry
- Potential future impact of the student on the region's construction community
- Quality of the application

Please note that there are no minimum or maximum selections for each college or technical school. Selection of the awardees is based on the above-mentioned criteria, regardless of college or technical school. <u>Award amounts may vary from**\$1,000** - **\$5,000** based on the above scoring criteria.</u>

Completed applications must be accompanied by a <u>school issued transcript</u> to be considered. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
